	Examples
Sites & Monuments	Decorative stones, carvings, castles, churches, crosses, houses, ringforts, souterrains.
Items you think are 'at risk'	Old buildings in need of repair, monuments covered in ivy (entrants should not interfere with a monument but take a photograph of it in its current state).
Industrial, Agricultural or Maritime Heritage	Farm implements, tools, gates, wrecks, boats, slipways, storehouses, railways.
Documents or Maps	Old deeds, wills, old letters, family bibles, estate maps or papers, diaries.
Old Photographs or Paintings	Towns and villages, street scenes, events, fairs, markets, religious processions, threshings, family photographs.

The aspects of heritage include: the unusual, the undiscovered, the unrecorded and the unidentified.

- Multiple entries are allowed but only one prize per entrant will be granted.
- The winners will be presented with their prizes during the month of June 2010.

- In case of an entry pertaining to a document, map or old photograph, the Society does not require the original to be submitted. A copy or scanned image will suffice. Prior to the awarding of prizes the Society reserves the right to view the original.
